

### Changing 'Denied' to 'Approved'

When PROMISe™ denies a claim, all is not lost. There are many reasons for the denial of a claim, but 90% of rejections are eligibility issues. Sometimes a student loses eligibility temporarily, but when eligibility resumes, previously rejected claims can be resubmitted successfully. Getting these claims PROMISe-approved makes my day.

Unfortunately, there are situations when a student's name or Medical Assistance number changes (or sometimes both), and that makes tracking eligibility more difficult. Rest assured that I will do whatever is possible to get a denied claim the stamp of approval.

FYI: From July 2007 to June 2008, \$241,270 of revenue was received from resubmitted claims.

### Data Storage

At the close of each school year, we archive a school year of claim-

ing data. This year, we archived all transactions

with a service date of July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. This data will not be deleted from billing history and is available upon request. The Purged Data Report can be found with June's Monthly Management Reports.



### Federal Medical Assistance Percentages (FMAP)

The FMAP for Fiscal Year 2009 has been calculated and will be effective October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009. Pennsylvania's FMAP will be 54.52 percent, increased slightly from Fiscal Year 2008.
